In Memoriam: Joe Pemberton

Our local bar lost a champion for justice when Joe Pemberton died on November 21, 2009, after a courageous battle with cancer. Joe, a third generation Whatcom County attorney, cared much less about chasing the dollar than about standing for justice and for those who are often left out of the abundance that most of us enjoy. Joe was a key, if not the key, founder of the organization that became LAW Advocates. For this work, he received the ABA Pro Bono Publico award in 1989. He is known at LAW Advocates for saying "yes," so very graciously to a pro bono request when a person without resources needed his help.
